



## 2011 National DOG Dessert Cook-off Rules Sponsored by Kitchen Collection



This cook-off is going to be a fun one. Bring your **best** Dutch oven dessert to the table and see how it holds up against the others!

1. You can start your dessert at 2:00 p.m. It must be turned in to the judges by 3:45 p.m. for judging at 4:00 p.m. If it is turned in later, points will be deducted.
2. A copy of your dessert submission recipe is not required. If you do turn in a copy with your dessert, you will receive extra points.
3. All desserts should be cooked in a Dutch oven and must take place on cook site; no submissions prepared offsite will be permitted. Dessert must be presented in a Dutch oven or on a Dutch oven lid. No additional sauce or condiments may accompany the dessert.
4. Garnishing should be simple and complement the dish being presented. This is not a garnishing contest. Doilies are allowed.
5. Once your dish is checked in, participants must leave the judging area.
6. All participants **MUST** practice safe food handling procedures.
7. All judging decisions are final. Prizes will be awarded for the top three entries. Awards will take place Saturday evening.
